Answer:

1278. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) does not provide electronic equipment to the Minister's office.
1279. The following equipment is owned by APRA and is made available to APRA staff:

1280. APRA utilises the Volume Sourcing Agreement coordinated by the Department of Finance to cover both the desktop licensing and software assurance for that software. APRA is currently running Microsoft Windows 7 Enterprise on its desktops and laptops. The costs associated with this are primarily covered by the Core Desktop Licensing Agreement that is managed by the Department of Finance. The cost of this arrangement is \$126,522.00 per annum.
