Lightweight laptop, docking station, external monitor	\$1,138	Nil – warranty is part of the initial purchase price	Senior executive or staff undertaking a significant amount of travel for business purposes.
Replacement Monitor	\$195	Nil - warranty is part of the initial purchase price	Standard device for all staff at APRA
RSA Token	\$55 for a 3yr token	Nil	All staff requiring remote access.
Encrypted USB Thumb Drive	\$50	Nil	Staff required to take or collect data offsite.
