Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014*:

- 1466. What has been the Department/Agency's hospitality spend including any catering and drinks costs.
- 1467. What has been the Department/Agency's entertainment spend? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events including any catering and drinks costs.
- 1468. What hospitality spend is the Department/Agency's planning on spending? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events including any catering and drinks costs.
- 1469. What entertainment spend is the Department/Agency's planning on spending? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events including any catering and drinks costs.
- 1470. Is the Department/Agency planning on reducing any of its spending on these items? If so, how will reductions be achieved?

Answer:

- 1466. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority's (APRA's) expenditure on hospitality and entertainment for the period 2 June to 30 October 2014 was \$1,778.89.
