# **Question:**

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

- 1899. For departments/agencies that provide mobile phones to Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices, what type of mobile phone has been provided and the costs?
  - a. Itemise equipment and cost broken down by staff or minister classification
- 1900. Has electronic equipment (such as iPad, laptop, wireless card, Vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive, video cameras) been provided by the department/agency? If yes provide a list of:
  - a. What is provided?
  - b. The purchase cost.
  - c. The ongoing cost.
  - d. A list of any accessories provided for the equipment and the cost of those accessories (e.g. iPad keyboards, laptop carry bags, additional chargers etc.)
  - e. A breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives each item.

# Answer:

1899. The ATO does not provide equipment to Treasury portfolio Ministers.

1990.

a. All ATO employees receive a standard desktop and monitor. Standard Notebook and encrypted thumb drives are issued to staff based on business need. To ensure economical use of these devices, they are able to be used in pooled or multiple user situations which are managed by user identification. This also assists with the monitoring of access and usage.

\* Individual ongoing cost does not include usage. The ATO purchases desktop and mobile equipment outright. There is no ongoing monthly hardware cost for equipment. The ATO however pays a monthly service fee for equipment e.g. the ongoing cost per device (GST exclusive) for a Standard Desktop is \$17.49 per month per employee. Pricing is in accordance with the Whole-of-Government desktop panel or Service Provider arrangements.

d. The ATO provides a standard kit for mobile computing (ROAM) users. This kit comprises a laptop, mouse, bag, network cable and a RSA Secure Identification token. The costs for electronic devices included in the standard kit are at the table above. The standard kit can be issued to multiple users however each user must have an individually allocated RSA Secure Identification token. Costs for other accessories included in the standard kit are in the table below.
