Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

2009. How much has been spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio to date?

  - b. Please specify how many reams of paper have been supplied to the Minister's office
2010. How much has been spent on departmental stationary requirements to date.

**Answer:**

2009. From 1 June to 31 October 2014, the ATO did not incur stationery costs for the Treasury Portfolio Ministers.
