# **Question:**

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

- 2042. How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed?
  - a. How many of these printed documents were also published online?
- 2043. Has the Department/Agency used external printing services for any print jobs?
  - a. If so, what companies were used?
  - b. How were they selected?
  - c. What was the total cost of this printing by item?

# Answer:

2042. From 1 June to 31 October 2014, 39,161,653 individual items were printed at a cost of \$1,397,011 (GST inclusive).
