Question:

- 2074. Does the department/agency have a program for staff to engage in self-initiated work (projects, plans etc that are devised by staff without being directed by the minister's office or department management)?
- 2075. Please list all ongoing projects. For each, please detail:
 - a) When did the project commence?
 - b) When is it expected to conclude?
 - c) What will the total cost of the project be?
 - d) Where did the money for the project come from?
 - e) Where is the project based?

Answer:

- 2074. Yes. The CEFC is an independent statutory authority governed by its own legislation, the *Clean Energy Finance Corporation Act 2012*. The Responsible Ministers provide the CEFC with a general direction about the Corporation's operations [the *Clean Energy Finance Corporation (Investment Mandate) Direction 2013*] but cannot direct the Corporation as to the making of specific investments. It follows that all of the Corporation's investment activity is self-initiated.
