Question:

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

- 282. How much did the department/agency spend on temporary or contract staff?
- 283. How many temporary or contract staff have been employed?
- 284. What is the total number of temporary or contract staff currently employed?
- 285. How much was paid for agencies/companies to find temporary/contract staff?
- 286. Have there been any changes to the policies/criteria that govern the appointment of contract staff?

Answer:

- 282. For the period 1 June to 31 October 2014, Treasury spent \$304,318.07
- 283. For the period 1 June to 31 October 2014, Treasury employed a total of 6 temporary/contract staff
- 284. Treasury currently have 5 temporary/contract staff
- 285. Nil
- 286. No. The *Commonwealth Procurement Rules* produced by the Department of Finance set out the rules that officials must comply with when procuring goods and/or services.
