**Question:**

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

394. How many ongoing staff have been recruited? What classification are these staff?
395. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created? What classification are these staff?
396. How many staff have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

**Answer:**

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

394. The Treasury has engaged two ongoing staff via section 26 transfers from other APS agencies. These staff were ongoing movements one at the EL2 level and the other at the SESB1 level.
395. The Treasury has engaged three non-ongoing staff during this period. These staff were engaged at the Executive Level 2, APS level 6 and APS Level 3. They were engaged to either meet peak workload or address short term critical vacancies across the department.
396. Contract staff are not recorded in Treasury's HRMIS (Aurion). To attempt to provide this information would be an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources.
