- a. What support is provided to GovHack from the Government?
- b. What access to Government data participants have, including which Government databases?
- c. What data management and security protocols are put in place for access to Government data at GovHack events?
- d. If funding for the program is ongoing?

ANSWER

- a. Department of Industry, Innovation and Science provided funds of \$11,550 for the 2014 and 2015 GovHack events. The Department has promoted GovHack, as well as the benefits of making government data publically accessible, through a number of forums.
