Please provide a comprehensive update on the status of the Disability (Access to Premises – Building) Standards review.

ANSWER

The Department of Industry, Innovation and Science (the department) is conducting the first five-yearly legislated review of the *Disability (Access to Premises – Buildings) Standards* 2010 (the Premises Standards) in consultation with the Attorney-General's Department. The aim of the review is to examine the effectiveness of the Premises Standards in achieving their objectives and to identify any necessary amendments.

The review commenced on 17 April 2015, with the release of the terms of reference, a discussion paper and a call for submissions.

Over 370 submissions have been received from a wide range of stakeholders. The department is now reviewing the submissions and undertaking additional targeted consultations, as appropriate.

The final review report will be provided to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and the Attorney-General by the legislated date of 1 May 2016.
