QUESTION No.: SI-99

Since the leadership change in September, 2015, how much has been spent by the Ministerial office on personalised stationery for the Minister and the Minister's staff? Please provide a cost breakdown by type of stationery purchased and the quantity of each and whether it was for the Minister or for staff.

ANSWER

\$3,563 (GST exclusive) was spent on personalised stationery across the Ministerial offices. Details for each office are below:

Minister Pyne: \$618 for 2,000 DL envelopes and 1,000 C4 envelopes, printed 'Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science'; and \$200 for 500 'With Compliments' slips.

Minister Frydenberg: \$618 for 2,000 DL envelopes and 1,000 C4 envelopes for use in the Ministerial office, printed 'Minister for Resources, Energy and Northern Australia', and \$200 for 500 'With Compliments' slips.

Assistant Minister Andrews: \$509 for 1,500 DL envelopes and 500 C4 envelopes for use in the Assistant Minister's office, printed 'Assistant Minister for Science', and \$200 for 500 'With Compliments' slips.

Assistant Minister Roy: \$1,018 for 3,000 DL envelopes and 1,000 C4 envelopes for use in the Assistant Minister's Office, printed 'Assistant Minister for Innovation', and \$200 for 500 'With Compliments' slips.
