**Answer:**

842. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) has four full-time staff employed within its Media and Communications team located in Sydney. The Media and Communications team's responsibilities include internal and external communications, media liaison and desktop publishing of documents, such as APRA's Annual Report, Insight and other corporate publications. The team comprises:
  - Head of Media and Communications;
  - Senior Communications Advisor;
  - Media and Communications Coordinator; and
  - Desktop Publisher/Graphic Designer.
843. APRA does not create non-ongoing positions. APRA fills roles either permanently or on a fixed-term basis.
844. As at 30 October 2015 there were no contractors engaged. APRA does engage staff on a contractor basis for discrete pieces of work.
