Senator KETTER: Could you please provide on notice a breakdown of all the Australian industry plans for Commonwealth projects by year, in the same format as the information that is provided for private projects on the website.

Mr Power: We can take that on notice.

ANSWER

In line with Section 22(3) of the *Australian Jobs Act 2013* (the Jobs Act), an executive summary for an AIP plan is published on the department's website on the day after the summary is received by the Authority for approval.

For a Commonwealth procurement, grant or investment, an executive summary for an AIP plan is published on the department's website only when the corresponding contract notice is published on AusTender, or when the grant or investment notice is published. This assists Australian industry seeking information on current opportunities to supply goods and services to projects.

An executive summary for an AIP plan developed for Commonwealth-funded infrastructure projects is not published on the department's website. These contracts are managed through the Department of Infrastructure and Regional Development.
