- 3) While a number of key staff with relevant expertise left the ACNC in the past 12 months, targeted recruitment has resulted in a number of talented staff joining the ACNC.
- 4) Staff morale has been high with the majority of staff reporting in the 2016 APS Census that they are engaged in their jobs, with their team, their supervisor and the agency overall. Recruitment activity has enabled the ACNC to advertise and permanently fill ongoing positions which has positively impacted morale.

The ACNC has recently implemented a Reward and Recognition scheme and a more structured learning and development capability which aims to further increase morale and engagement.
