Question:

Senator KETTER: Can you explain to me what is involved in a top-down estimate. What is the process?

Mr M Brennan: Sorry, it is just that an aggregate saving would have been calculated for the period over the forward estimates and then extrapolated. The aggregate would have been extrapolated over the medium term. But I will check that on notice.

Answer:

The impact on projected government debt from the Omnibus Savings Bill was calculated by using the projected impact on the underlying cash balance over the medium term as a starting point, and then projecting a scenario for government debt based on assumptions about debt issuance and bond yields.
