## Staffing profile

### Question

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

Has there been any change to the staffing profile of the department/agency?
Provide a list of changes to staffing numbers, broken down by classification level, division,

home base location (including town/city and state)

### Answer

- 1. Yes, primarily as a result of the transfer of Early Childhood and Child Care responsibilities from the Department of Social Services to the Department of Education and Training.
- 2. As at 31 August 2015 the Department of Education and Training had 1,644 employees. At 22 February 2016 the Department of Education and Training had 2,094 employees.

A breakdown by cluster, classification, and location comparing the staffing profile at 31 August 2015 to the staffing profile at 22 February 2016, has been provided in tables 1, 2 and 3.
