## Travel costs - department

#### Question

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. Is the minister or their office or their delegate required to approve all departmental and agency international travel?
- 2. If so, under what policy?
- 3. Provide a copy of that policy.
- 4. When was this policy implemented?
- 5. When is the minister notifed, when is approved provided?
- 6. Detail all travel (domestic and international) for Departmental officers that accompanied the Minister and/or Parliamentary Secretary on their travel. Please include a total cost plus a breakdown that include airfares (and type of airfare), accommodation, meals and other travel expenses (such as incidentals).
- 7. Detail all travel for Departmental officers. Please include a total cost plus a breakdown that include airfares (and type of airfare), accommodation, meals and other travel expenses (such as incidentals). Also provide a reason and brief explanation for the travel.
- 8. What date was the minister or their office notified of the travel?
- 9. What date did the minister or their office approve the travel?
- 10. What travel is planned for the rest of this calendar year? Also provide a reason and brief explanation for the travel.

#### Answer

- 1-4. The minister is required to approve departmental international travel where the estimated cost exceeds \$20 000. This is accordance with the department's Secretary's Instructions, current as of 29 February 2016. The instruction was implemented on 1 July 2014. Please see Attachment A for Secretary Instruction 3.3 Official travel.
- 5. There have been no instances of international travel requiring Ministerial approval in the period 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016.
- 6. The department does not record travel data in a way that would readily allow answers to be provided for this question.

- 7. For the period 14 September 2015 to 31 January 2016, the Department of Education and Training spent \$1,637,988.84 on travel expenses. The breakdown of the expenses is:
  - \$660,525.88 for domestic airfares and \$339,110.46 for international airfares
  - \$339,005.55 for accommodation
  - \$299,346.95 on other costs.
- 8-9. There was no travel that required notification to or approval from the Minister or their office.
- 10. The department does not specifically budget or plan for individual travel. Travel is one cost of the department's business of national policy leadership and programme administration and is undertaken for a range of purposes.

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
