Answer

The Australian Research Council (ARC) has provided the following response.

- 1. Nil
- The ARC is in the process of moving from PCs to a laptop solution using 125 HP Spectrex360 laptops and 35 Dell Precision M3800 laptops located at ARC Canberra Airport. Lease cost - quarterly payments of \$25,598.34 over four years. The solution includes soft carry bag, additional charger (HP \$32.18 x 125, Dell \$45.56 x 35) and docking station (\$160.00 x 160).
- 3. 160 x Windows 10 on laptops under AGIMO Microsoft VSA II, \$22,500 per year. The PCs being replaced have Windows 7 Enterprise installed under the same Microsoft VSA II agreement.
