HELP - DNER calculation

Question

Has there been any internal or external evaluation of the process used to calculate DNER and other key performance measures associated with the HELP program? How were these measures initially developed? Have there been any changes in the accounting process and, if so, what is the nature of these changes?

Answer

The key performance indicators (KPIs) for HELP were developed by the department as a comparable way of monitoring the progress of the programme. These KPIs are monitored on an ongoing basis by the department, drawing on technical analysis and advice from the Australian Government Actuary. The KPIs have not been externally evaluated. There have been no changes to the accounting process since the KPIs were introduced as part of the department's 2012–13 Portfolio Budget Statements.
