ASQA: Workplace assessments

Question

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments?
- (a) List each item of expenditure and cost
- 2. Have any assessments, not related to an existing disability, resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up?
- 3. If so, list each item of expenditure and cost related to those changes

Answer

The Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA) has provided the following response:

1. ASQA has spent \$1886.50 on workplace ergonomic assessments since 14 September 2015. The breakdown of these costs is as follows:
