The department does not estimate below the national level the caseload of job seekers who are receiving services from jobactive providers.

As at 31 December 2015, 531,068 job seekers were receiving services from jobactive providers. This is around 50,000 fewer than estimated and does not include job seekers suspended from receiving services from their provider or job seekers who have been referred to a provider but have not yet commenced with them.

The same comparison is not available at an employment region level.
