ASQA - MAP Training

Question

What was the nature of the administrative sanction that resulted in an amended scope for MAP Training (provider number 90791) as reported in the ASQA 2012-2013 Annual Report, (p 136)?

Answer

The Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA) has provided the following response

On 8 October 2012 the Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA) decided to impose a sanction on MAP Training Pty Ltd (RTO No. 90791) under section 37(2) and section 36(2) of the *National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011*. The sanction imposed was:

- Amend the scope of registration of Map Training Pty Ltd to remove:
 - CPC31508 Certificate III in Formwork/Falsework

ASQA made this decision following the conduct of an audit of the RTO, where:

- the RTO did not demonstrate compliance with the VET Quality Framework
- the RTO did not demonstrate compliance with the following Standards for NVR Registered Training Organisations 2011:
 - SNR 15.3 - the RTO did not address all the non-compliances in relation to assessments and therefore did not demonstrate that its assessment materials are consistent with the requirements of the training package.
 - SNR 15.5 - the RTO did not demonstrate that its assessment tasks for *CPCCCM1015A Carry out measurements and calculations* from CPC31508 Certificate III in FormWork/Falsework fully addressed the requirements of the training package.
 - SNR 18.1 - the RTO did not demonstrate how its CEO would ensure that the RTO complies with the VET Quality Framework.
