## TEQSA - developing quality

### Question

What type of sector-wide guidance or research does TEQSA give in relation to developing quality in the higher education sector?

### **Answer**

The Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency (TEQSA) has provided the following response.

In accordance with the *Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency Act 2011* Ministerial Direction No. 2 of 2013, TEQSA works to improve sectoral quality assessment activities where it has surplus resources after fulfilling its key activities of provider registration and re-registration applications, course accreditation and re-accreditation applications.

Examples of TEQSA's sector-wide research, guidance and communication include:

- overview reports such as the Key Financial Metrics report and the Statistics Report on TEQSA Registered Higher Education Providers
- briefings and guidance notes in relation to the transition to, and interpretation and application of, the *Higher Education Standards Framework (Threshold Standards)* 2015
- allocation of case managers to respond to any questions from providers
- dedicated resources to engage with stakeholders in responding to sectoral issues, such as the maintenance of academic integrity.
