#### *Students with disability*

#### Question

What is the total funding for students with disability for each state and territory government in each year between 2017 and 2020?

#### Answer

On 2 May 2017 the Australian Government announced the *Quality Schools* package. The fact sheet *Fairer funding for students with disability* provides relevant information: [www.education.gov.au/quality-schools](http://www.education.gov.au/quality-schools).

Estimated 2017 Commonwealth funding attributable to students with disability through the students with disability loading provided to state and territory governments for government schools is set out in the table below.

*\*Calculated based on notional loading allocations as at the 2017–18 Budget. Does not include funding provided under the additional funding for students with disability measure for the 2016 and 2017 calendar years, announced in the 2016-17 Budget. Figures do not include funding from states and territories, which are the primary funders of schools.*

Funding for students with disability for each state and territory government in 2018-2020 can only be calculated when the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability data is available for each of those years.
