University research programmes

Question

Does it not run counter to the government's 'innovation agenda' and Malcolm Turnbull's 'Ideas Boom' to cut university research programmes?

Answer

Through its National Innovation and Science Agenda (NISA), the Australian Government has invested an additional \$180 million over the forward estimates to incentivise greater university and industry linkages that can benefit all Australians, as part of the new research block grant arrangements commencing on 1 January 2017.

In addition, under NISA, the Government has committed operational funding of \$150 million per year (indexed) to the National Collaborative Research Infrastructure Strategy (NCRIS) from 1 July 2017, to provide ongoing funding certainty and job security to some 1700 researchers and technical experts employed on NCRIS projects.
