Question

Program launch costs - financial year to date

Answer

Program launches involve the announcement of a new program which attracts an event. This response covers program launch activities organised by the Department's centralised events team where a catering/venue hire cost was expended.

This level of detailed reporting was reasonably accessible as it is managed within the one team. To compile details of program launch events across the Department which may have been held but were not managed by the events team, would require an unreasonable allocation of resources as the data would need to be collated from a significant number of separate line areas.
