#### Question

## Trade Training Centres targeting qualifications on the National Skills Needs List

Senator NASH: Of the centres built to date, how many are specifically targeting qualifications that appear on the National Skills Needs List?

Ms Harrison: We will need to take that on notice. I would say the majority of them, but there are some that are delivering occupations in local demand.

#### **Answer**

As at 31 May 2013, 375 Trade Training Centres (TTCs) have been approved for funding through Rounds One to Four of the TTC Program.

In Rounds One to Two, in addition to qualifications leading to trades on the National Skills Needs List (NSNL), TTCs were able to offer qualifications in emerging industries. TTCs could also offer qualifications in agriculture, rural operations and horticulture where the school was able to demonstrate significant support from local industry.

In Rounds Three to Four, qualifications in emerging industries were replaced with the category of 'occupations in local demand (OLD)'. Schools were able to seek approval to deliver OLD qualifications where they could demonstrate relevant occupations experiencing local or regional skill shortage or emerging demand.

Attachment A shows the number of TTC projects in each funding round that have been approved to deliver qualifications on the NSNL, as well as in the other categories that applied during each round.

### **APPROVED QUALIFICATIONS**

The table below shows the number of projects approved for each funding round under the TTC Program and identifies the number of projects that have been approved to deliver qualifications leading to trades on the National Skills Needs List (NSNL), as well as qualifications in other categories. Where an individual TTC project will deliver qualifications in one or more categories, the project has been counted in each relevant column of the table.
