Question

Trade Training Centres in Indigenous communities

Senator GALLACHER: I am talking particularly about the model where the schools that supply the trades training centre are all Indigenous community schools. I am trying to work out whether the TTC in the APY lands is of its own kind. Ms Harrison: I will take that on notice. Senator GALLACHER: That is a trades training centre in a situation where you need a permit to go in. The drawing schools are all the Indigenous schools in the area. I am wondering if that is one of a kind or if there are other models that are already operational and working. Ms Harrison: I will take that on notice.

Answer

The Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Trade Training Centre (TTC) is the only trade training centre where a permit is required by Commonwealth Officers who may visit the TTC.

Ernabella Anangu School is the lead school for the Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara TTC which was funded under Round Three of the TTC Program. The other schools in this cluster are:
