### Question

# University fees - domestic students

The NSW Auditor General reports that international student fees in that State rose by 32 per cent in the four years to 2012 – is this the kind of increase the Department is expecting in fees for domestic students, under the new arrangements announced in the Budget?

#### **Answer**

The Government does not expect movements in fees for domestic students and overseas students to be the same, as they will be subject to different influences. For example, domestic fees are unlikely to be influenced by exchange rates to the same extent as overseas fees.
