Answer Department

1. The Department of Education's Pay TV subscription is a package containing Sky News, Sky Business and Australian Public Affairs (APAC) channels. The subscriptions provide both national and international perspectives and breaking news on a broad range of issues which both directly and indirectly impact on the work of the department.

For the period 1 March 2014 to 30 June 2014 the Department of Education¹ paid \$792.03 for pay TV services.

The Education Ministers' offices are provided with the Business Premium package. For the period 1 March 2014 to 30 June 2014 the Education Ministers' offices paid \$704.55 for pay TV services.
