Question

Schools funding ministerial correspondence

In relation to Ministerial correspondence (including electronic correspondence):

- a. Since the 2014 Budget, how much correspondence has the Minister received in relation to schools funding?
- b. How many items of correspondence have been responded to?
- c. What is the average time taken to respond?
- d. How many items of correspondence has the Minister signed? How many by his office? How many have been managed by the Department?
- e. (i) How many items related to school funding and cuts announced in the Budget?
 - (ii) What proportion has supported the cuts?
 - (iii) What proportion has opposed?

Answer

- a. The Minister received 29 letters for response.
- b. As at 30 June 2014:
 - (i). Six have been completed;
 - (ii). Eleven are in the final stages of clearance;
 - (iii). Twelve have not yet reached their due date.
- c. 18 working days
- d. All six were signed by the Minister; no correspondence was for the office or department to sign.
- e. (i). 29 records related to School funding, of which 20 mentioned funding levels announced in the Budget.
 - (ii). No letters expressed support for the Budget announcements.
 - (iii). 17 letters expressed disagreement with Budget announcements.
