Functional efficiency review

Question

Senator O'NEILL: Can we go through it now that we have got a bit of an overview? Let's go through it clearly. We have got \$131 million. Then you have mentioned \$115 million. Mr Cook: \$115 million is as a result of the functional efficiency review that is done by an independent reviewer—that is correct.

Senator O'NEILL: And then we are breaking it down a little further from there. Mr Griew: I was just pointing out there was some departmental but most of it was administered.

Senator O'NEILL: That is all the information you can give me?

Mr Cook: Happy to take that on notice. Some of that is about rationalisation of existing programs. Some of that was actually redesign. In BP 2 it talks about redesigning programs such as the Endeavour Language Teacher Fellowships program and things like that. What the functional efficiency review did was look at some of the cases where there might be duplications—for example, across Commonwealth, states and territories—and make some recommendations to government around that, which might have resulted in some shaving off of some particular programs. There are quite a number of these, which is why we have to take it on notice for you. I think there might be some amounts where redesign is going to be a saving of \$20,000 or \$30,000 of the \$115 million. To give you the accurate information, it would be good if I could take that on notice so we could give you the detail around that.
