Increase in funding over 20 years

Question

Senator SINODINOS: Maybe this one is more to take on notice. We have been increasing spending—this is across the board politically—on schools during the last 20 years, have we not?

Mr Cook: Yes. That is right. I think the figure we were using that Senator Wright was asking for from, I think

2003 to about 2011 or 2012 represents a 44.1 per cent increase. The funding continues to increase.

Senator SINODINOS: Sure. I am asking for the last 20 years.

Mr Cook: I will have to take that on notice.

Senator SINODINOS: Take that on notice. Is there a national funding agreement around all this, or have we got a series of agreements with particular states and territories? What is going on here?

Answer

According to the Report on Government Services (RoGS), total Australian Government recurrent expenditure increased from \$20.688 billion to \$47.941 billion, or by 132 per cent, over the period 1999–2000 to 2012–2013.

Funding data provided in RoGS prior to 1999–2000 cannot be directly compared due to a move from cash to accrual accounting in 1999–2000.
