Question

How much funding per student does the department currently estimate it will be providing for government, Catholic and Independent schools in 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019? Please supply state and territory figures as well as national figures by sector.

Answer

Table 1 provides the estimated Commonwealth per-student amounts of recurrent funding by state and sector.

As per the 2015-16 Federal Budget, state and territory allocations from the 2018 school year onwards are indicative only and subject to formal negotiations between the Commonwealth, states and territories and the non-government sector.
