**Question**

Senator O'NEILL: Yes, so the school is the school is the school. The school is in a particular electorate. I am asking why the data that you have for schools cannot be disaggregated by electorate.

Mr Cook: We will take it on notice and see what we can do for you.

Senator O'NEILL: Thank you very much. If you can do that, could you also find out the proportion that are enrolled full-time and part-time. Is it possible for you to ask the states to provide that sort of information?

Senator Ryan: We will take that on notice, conscious that there are resource limits within the department. I know in Health, for example, they have often produced this on a regular basis, and it gets tabled, but there are resource constraints, so we will take that on notice.

**Answer**

Numbers of students with disability are not available by electorate.

States and territories do not provide data on numbers of students with disability by full-time or part-time status.
