### Question

- 1. What are the main priorities that AITSL is pursuing at the moment, and have there been any recent changes to these priorities?
- 2. What are the staffing numbers in AITSL? The Budget papers indicate a reduction in staff over the next financial year, which areas will lose staff and will this have an effect on the operations of AITSL?
- 3. Please provide an update on all research or reports AITSL is currently and their expected completion date?

#### **Answer**

The Australian Institute for Teaching and School Leadership (AITSL) has provided the following response:

- 1. AITSL has three areas of focus:
  - Initial Teacher Education (major focus)
  - School Leadership
  - Teaching
- 2. AITSL has moved from 62 staff in 2013-14 to 56 in the 2015-16 financial year. With a number of staff departures through resignation, retirements and the conclusion of fixed-term contracts, there have been some efficiencies through a realignment of the organisational structure.
- 3. AITSL commissions a range of reports and research to support and inform its work. Research and reports currently underway:
