#### Research Infrastructure Review

### Question

In relation to the Research Infrastructure Review:

- a) What has the review cost in total?
- b) Please provide a breakdown of costs associated with the review by contract, staffing costs, travel costs and any other components of the total cost?
- c) Why was the review not completed by the end of May 2015?
- d) When is the review now expected to be completed?
- e) How many stakeholders were consulted as part of the review process? Please provide a breakdown between state governments, universities, publicly funded research agencies and research infrastructure providers.

#### Answer

(a) and (b) Total costs for the review as at 30 May 2015 are outlined in the following table.

- (c) The Review has been extended at the request of the Chairman to allow time for additional consultations and to finalise the report.

- (e) Stakeholders from 85 organisations were consulted: 20 universities, 12 Commonwealth departments and agencies, 35 research infrastructure providers, three publicly funded research agencies, nine other bodies, and the NSW, South Australian, Victorian, Queensland, Tasmanian and Western Australian state governments.
