## Question

In relation to the restructure of Assessment and Reporting:

- 1. Please provide the date that ACARA staff in these areas were:
- a. first advised of a restructure in 2013/14,
- b. finally advised that the restructure was complete in 2014/15,
- 2. Provide a copy of the written advice which went to Assessment and Reporting staff on these dates.
- 3. What were the reasons for the restructure being unresolved for this period?
- 4. What further restructure/s does ACARA plan in its Assessment and Reporting areas for the 2015/16 year? What is the intended duration of any such actions.
- 5. Does ACARA plan any restructures elsewhere in its structure for the 2015/16 year? What is the intended duration of any such actions.

## **Answer**

The Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA) has provided the following response.

- 1. Assessment and Reporting (A&R) restructure
  - a. On 20/5/2014, all staff were advised of the restructure at an All Staff meeting. On 16/6/2014 (all staff were updated by email)
  - b. On 7/10/2014, the CEO advised all A&R staff that the process was complete except that the remaining positions subject to possible redundancy (4 Senior Project Officers reducing to 3 positions) would have contracts extended to 31/1/2015. The three remaining positions were confirmed (from 3/2/2015) following the internal appointment of one affected staff member to another position within ACARA. This finalised the A&R restructure.
- 2. Provide a copy of the written advice:
  - a. 20/5/2014 was Verbal no written advice.
  - b. 7/10/2014. Attached is the email sent to all A&R staff, titled '*Update on A&R* structure'. Names and contact details have been redacted for privacy reasons.
- 3. The timeline for this restructure was extended because of the appointment of a new General Manager, Assessment & Reporting (21/7/2014) and subsequent senior appointments during the following months.
- 4. There are currently no plans for an Assessment & Reporting restructure in the 2015/16 vear.
- 5. There are currently no plans for further ACARA restructures in the 2015/16 year.
