Answer

The Australian Research Alliance for Children and Youth (ARACY) is contracted for the period of 2014–15 to 2017–18. The work programme under this contract is negotiated and agreed to by the department on an annual basis.

As part of its agreement ARACY is required to:

- create a shared understanding of parent engagement
- build the profile of parent engagement
- develop a measurement and evaluation framework
- develop a (technical) definition of parent engagement
- develop a 'What Works' database of best practice programmes
- focus on developing Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander specific parent engagement capacity.
