Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA) – Estimates Hearing 3 June 2015

I am writing in relation to ASQA's appearance before the Education and Employment — Legislation Committee's 2015–16 Budget Estimates hearing on Wednesday 3 June 2015.

I wish to correct information inadvertently presented in evidence to the Committee in response to questions from Senators Carr and Rhiannon (pages 43, 44 & 46 of Hansard refers) relating to the status of the training provider BAWN Pty Ltd.

I had stated that this provider was no longer operating. However, at the time of the hearing, the provider was still operating as part of a regulatory process put in place by the Victorian Registration Qualifications Authority whereby BAWM would undertake a teach-out process prior to its registration being cancelled. I can now confirm that BAWM ceased operation on 23 June 2015.

It would be appreciated if you could draw this fact to the attention of the Committee. I apologise for any inconvenience caused by this inadvertent oversight.
