## **FWBC** - Details of presentation

Senator LINES: So somebody knows.

Mr Hadgkiss: As I understand it, these statistics were obtained from the document called 'Work-related Traumatic Injury Fatalities'.

Senator LINES: Yes, and I have just heard someone at the back of room say it was an extract. Perhaps we can have some officers at the table who can answer the questions? Mr Hadgkiss: I will take that on notice.

Senator LINES: What, that we can have another officer at the table?
