Outcome 1 - Employment

Question

Employment Pathway Fund

In response to questions on notice from Additional Estimates 2014-2015, the Department advised that between 1 July 2009 to 28 February 2015 a total of \$854.2m was paid from the Employment Pathway Fund on training with respect to 839,635 job seekers.

- 1. How many different courses did job seekers participate in during this period?
- 2. Can a list of all courses these job seekers participated in be provided?
- 3. How many different training providers were utilised to deliver the training?
- 4. Of these job seekers, how many reported they obtained employment following participating in training?

Answer

- Q1. Since 1 July 2012, the department has been able to identify the number of job seekers who have participated in different types of training funded through the Employment Pathway Fund (EPF), as shown in Attachment A. It is important to note that from 1 July 2015, under jobactive, all training reimbursed from the new Employment Fund must be either accredited or directly required by an employer.
- Q2, Q3. Administrative system limitations prevent the department from accurately providing the unique number and names of training courses that were funded through the EPF or associated training course providers.
- Q4. The Labour Market Assistance Outcome report for December 2014 shows that 28.1 per cent of job seekers were employed after leaving vocational training courses (including those funded through the EPF).
