## **SWA - Amending labels**

What is the estimated cost to the agricultural and veterinary chemicals sector of amending labels to meet SWA requirements?

## **Answer**

The Decision Regulation Impact Statement for National Harmonisation of Work Health and Safety Regulations and Codes of Practice relies on the analysis of costs for revising labels for agricultural and veterinary chemicals originally published in the Regulatory Impact Statement: Proposed Revisions to the National OHS Framework for the Control of Workplace Hazardous Substances and Dangerous Goods.

The Regulatory Impact Statement considers the total cost to the agricultural and veterinary chemical sector of revising labels to include Hazard and Precautionary Statements to be \$6.9 million (measured in 2009 dollars) incurred over the five year transition period which will finish on 31 December 2016.
