Question

Departmental Dispute Resolution

 - 2. Amount paid to each firm since the last budget.

 - 6. Please provide a list of disputes referred to the firm, including a brief description of the dispute.

Answer

The Department response to disputes between staff is determined having regard to the particular circumstances. In some instances the Department does arrange for mediation to occur, which is facilitated by a suitably qualified person either internal to the Department or from an outside firm.

Between 31 May 2014 and 31 May 2015 no outside firms were contracted to assist the Department to facilitate a mediation process.
