Staff disputes and conflict are mediated using both internal and external resources. External resources are usually procured where there is conflict involving multiple staff or for team conflict.

The following outside firms were contracted and procured during the 2014–15 financial year:

- i) Carfi
- ii) Proactive Resolutions

a. The structure of payments made to each firm (e.g. retainers, fees for each consultation etc.)

- i) Carfi have been contracted to conduct two interventions for Comcare. Carfi were engaged to conduct two separate mediations with fees payable for each consultation;
- ii) Proactive Resolutions was selected to conduct one mediation/intervention for Comcare.

b. Amount paid to each firm since the last budget

- i) Carfi have been paid a total of \$57,554 for its work;
- ii) Proactive Resolutions were paid a total of \$23,100 for its work.
