### Question

#### Number of redundancies

Senator CAMERON: Have there been any redundancies, forced or otherwise, since last estimates? Ms Leon: There certainly have not been any forced redundancies and there have not been any widespread redundancies, but, from time to time, we have the occasional one-off redundancy. I will just check if there have been any since last estimates. Ms Kidd: There has been a small number since last estimates—five. Senator CAMERON: What kind of classifications were they? Ms Kidd: I do not have the classifications here. We can take that on notice. Senator CAMERON: Were there any SES? Ms Kidd: No.

## Answer

Five employees in the Department of Employment received voluntary redundancies between 1 July 2015 and 31 March 2016.

Two employees were at the Executive Level (EL) 2, and one was an EL1, APS6 and APS4 classification level.
