Hi

As discussed, builders licensing is experience based as opposed to qualification based, therefore is currently no qualification based pathway that will secure a builders supervisor registration for residential or commercial building work up to 2 stories.

Requirements are based on time of application also so I can only speak for the current requirements at this point in time as opposed to any future requirements that could be subject to changes.

It is important to note that there are other requirements - more so when it comes to the contracting such as fitness and propriety, business qualifications and financial requirements as mentioned previously. I have attached these guidelines again for you reference.

Considering the above, provided an applicant demonstrates competency in the performance criteria attached, through the technical interview, this would currently satisfy the experience component of obtaining a supervisor registration.

In which case any training or knowledge is going to benefit the applicant, however does not guarantee the interview outcome.
