Answer

All tender assessment reports relating to the Adult Migrant English Program and Skills for Education and Employment program Request for Tender are commercial-in-confidence. Attachment B, of the Government Guidelines for Official Witnesses before Parliamentary Committees and Related Matters (February 2015) deals with the provision of commercial-inconfidence material to the Senate. Attachment B states that 'As a general guide, it would be inappropriate to disclose information that could disadvantage a contractor and advantage their competitors in future tender processes' to a senate committee.

The disclosure of tender assessment reports which for example contain information about price for services delivered, could disadvantage TAFE and Navitas and advantage their competitors in future tender rounds.
