Commonwealth Grant Scheme

Question

Senator JACINTA COLLINS: Can the department provide the growth projections which would impact the Commonwealth Grant Scheme funding for the following over the forwards: (a) growth in undergraduate places overall and for each university; (b) growth in subbachelor places overall and for each university; (c) growth or decline in postgraduate coursework Commonwealth supported places overall and for each university. Dr Bruniges: We will have to take that one on notice.

Answer

It is not possible to establish reliable projections for sub-bachelor places, undergraduate and postgraduate for each university, or the split between sub-bachelor and bachelor places at the sector level, as these places will be affected by decisions that are yet to be taken by universities and students in response to the higher education measures announced in the 2017–18 Budget.

The table below shows the aggregate projections for Commonwealth supported places at the undergraduate and postgraduate level as at the 2017–18 Budget.
